Notice for online counselling (Round 2) to fill up West Bengal State Quota Post Graduate Medical/Dental seats in 2016

The Round 2 online counseling to fill up West Bengal State Quota Post Graduate Medical and Dental seats in 2016 will start on **16 May 2016**.

The updated seat matrix will be prepared taking into consideration the returned vacant All India Quota seats if any in addition to non-allotted, non-reported and surrendered seats of State Quota Round 1. **The published seat matrix will show actual vacancies only.** The virtual vacancies will be available to the candidates while filling up choices. The allotment in virtual seats will only be possible if any candidate admitted earlier in these seats gets up-graded(Changed). Details are already discussed in frequently asked questions document attached in www.wbmcc.nic.in

No fresh registration will be allowed in this round. In order to participate in Round the Registered candidates have to fill choices afresh irrespective of whether they are admitted in Round 1 or not.

The following candidates will be allowed to participate in round 2:

1. Registered candidate who have not been allotted any seat in Round 1.
2. Registered candidate who was allotted a seat in Round 1, got admitted at the allotted institute and expressed willingness to participate in Round 2.
3. Candidate if registered in Round 1 but not filled choice in Round 1 will be able to fill choice in the Round 2.
4. Registered reserved candidate who was allotted a seat in Round 1, reported at the allotted institute but whose seat was cancelled due to insufficient documents regarding their reserved category (SC/ST/OBC/OBC-A/OBC-B/PH) but still remained eligible to participate in subsequent round with changed category (Unreserved) as the case may be.

The following candidates will not be able to fill choice in Round 2:

1. Candidates who are not registered for counseling during Round 1.
2. Candidates who have allotted but not reported in Round 1.
3. Resigned after reporting in Round 1.
4. Whose seat was cancelled in Round 1 due to valid cause and candidate became ineligible to participate in subsequent round.

5. Candidate not willing for participation in subsequent round as expressed during the online reporting in Round 1.

Choice of seats:

A. Actual – As shown in seat matrix of this round.

B. Virtual-

- I) For Open or In-service Group candidates
Seats of other categories (SC/ST/OBC/OBC-A/OBC-B/PH) of the same group
- II) For Open or In-service Group candidates
Seats of other group (seats of Open group for In-service candidates and vice-versa)

As **seat conversion** within open type and in-service type group (intra group) will take place in this round (if required number of candidates are not available to fill all the seats in a particular category), candidates can fill requisite choices of seats belonging to other categories of same group keeping in mind that Reserved category **candidate can fill choices in Unreserved Seat only if they have secured 50% or higher marks in WBPGMAT 2016 or WBPGDAT 2016.**

Candidates are also allowed to fill ALL the choices of seats belonging to other group (the intergroup , i e open candidate in the in-service and vice versa) , but these choices will not be processed in this round. These choices will only be processed if any vacancy arises due to any reason after completion of admission in this phase of Round 2.

Upgraded candidate in Round 2 will have to directly report to the newly allotted institute.

No online relieving letter is required to be generated from the computer system if a candidate is up graded in this Round 2 or subsequently.

The upgraded candidate is not required to produce the original documents to the newly allotted institute which are already submitted to the allotted institute in Round 1. **Only producing the RECEIPT of the original documents submitted to the earlier allotted college is enough.**

Their original documents will be sent to the colleges where the candidates get finally admitted after completion of the online counseling for 2016 (i.e. after 31st May 2016).

The rest of the essential original documents as mentioned in the Frequently asked Questions document hoisted in the website www.wbmcc.nic.in have to be shown to the newly upgraded college and the self attested photocopies of all the requisite documents have to be submitted.

Only the admission fee is non refundable but the other fees (e.g. tuition fees, caution deposit etc) must be refunded to the up graded candidate.

The upgraded candidate may visit the previously allotted institute for the refund of the other fees after completion of the online counseling for 2016 (i.e. after 31 May 2016).

Requisite bond and fee have to be paid to respective newly upgraded institute. Bond furnished earlier in the previous college will automatically be inoperative after admission on the basis of Round 2.

For completing the admission process all the steps like online reporting, documentation, bond submission and payment of fees must be done. If any single step is missed by the candidate within the stipulated time frame provided above, the admission will not be valid.

This admission is purely provisional and if in any stage it is found that candidate is not eligible or have opted unfair means or fraudulence for admission then his/her candidature will be at once cancelled and he/she will have no claim in that admitted seat.

Non allotted seats after this phase in Round 2 will be shifted to the other group. (non-allotted in-service seats to open group and vice –versa.)

The such shifted seats if any, will be categorized in the new group as per Reservation Rules. However non reported/cancelled/resigned seats remain within the respective group as before.

There will be no fresh choice filling in the next phase of Round 2 for filling the residual vacancies

Candidates are required to carefully give choice in Round 2 and arrange them in order of preference to be considered here for up-gradation or fresh allotment. If a particular choice (subject and college) is available in both open and in-service group then a single choice will suffice.

The candidates who are not allotted any seat in Round-1 and /or Round 2 will have to submit the essential original documents as mentioned below to the West Bengal University of Health Science (WBUHS) between working hours of 11 am to 3 pm during 23rd to 25th May 2016. After depositing the documents the candidates will receive the RECEIPT of documents. Choices of such candidates who deposited their documents along with intending candidates who are admitted in Round 1 and/or Round 2. will be considered for allotment of residual seats. The deposition of documents is made compulsory to reduce seat wastage due to non-reporting. If any candidate after being allotted a seat in Round 2 or subsequent, does not report to the allotted institute, not only his/her candidature will be cancelled but also required penalty bond will be imposed on him/her. **The requisite penalty has to paid in order to take the deposited original documents back.**

Non allotted candidates after Round 2 may take back their deposited documents from WBUHS after 31st May 2016 **showing the RECEIPT without any penalty.**

The original documents that have to be submitted to WBUHS are as follows:

1. Final MBBS/BDS mark sheet
2. MBBS/BDS degree certificate (provisional for who passed in 2015 and afterwards)
3. MBBS/BDS council registration certificate (MCI/DCI/State Medical Council in India/State Dental council in India)

The candidates who are admitted in a particular institute during Round 1 and/or Round 2 West Bengal State Quota online counseling 2016, are not required to submit documents at WBUHS.

This submission of exemption is **not applicable** for a candidate who has been admitted in any PG Medical/Dental seat under All India Quota 2016 online counseling. **These candidates if otherwise eligible to be considered, have to submit original documents to WBUHS within the stipulated time as mentioned earlier.**

The choices of the following candidates will not be processed in the next phase if occurred:

1. Candidates not reported in Round 2 or
2. Candidates who resigned after reporting in Round 2 or
3. Candidates whose seat was cancelled in Round 2 due to valid cause and candidate became ineligible to participate in subsequent round or
4. Candidate not willing for participation in subsequent phase of round 2 as expressed during online reporting in Round 2
5. Candidate not allotted a seat in Round 1 or Round 2 but **not deposited** original documents to WBUHS within stipulated time frame.

The choices of the following candidates will be processed for up-gradation:

1. Candidates who have expressed **willingness for choice up-gradation** while admission in round 2.
2. Candidate not allotted a seat in Round 1 or Round 2 and has **deposited** original documents to WBUHS within stipulated time frame.

The last day of resignation without bond penalty in a West Bengal PG State Quota Medical and Dental seat for 2016-2017 admissions is **10th May 2016 up to 4 pm** and the resignation facility will be available online at the reporting institutes.

After the process of admission, the list of candidates who did not report after allotment of seats will be published in the website and action in debarring them for subsequent entrance examination will be taken as per provision of clause 2.11 of Information Booklet in respect of West Bengal Post Graduate Medical Admission Test 2016.
